Number plates will be issued to riders by the Club Team Manager and must be used within this event, including all official practice sessions.

A rider holding a 1 – 8 ranking from the following meetings; Worlds 2017, BMX NZ National Championships 2017, Oceania Continental Championships 2017, North Island Titles 2016 or South Island Titles 2017 and wish to use this number at the meeting, the ranking must be clearly marked on the entry form. All riders not entering with these rankings or with an incorrect ranking will be issued with randomly selected numbers.

## RACING FORMAT

### MOTO DRAW:

BMX NZ computer moto mixing & lane draws  
Quarter & Semi Finals – snake seeding method

### LANE DRAW SELECTION:

Quarters, Semis and Main Finals Only. Order of lane choice based on count back to moto points.

### MINIMUM CLASS SIZE

5 riders constitute a class (amalgamations as required). Class sizes will be determined after the close of entries for trophy allocation purposes.

### CHALLENGE 20" & CRUISER Classes:

4 motos Saturday, 2 motos Sunday then finals (depending on class sizes)

<b>8 or less riders:</b>	4 motos Saturday, 3 motos Sunday, points aggregated
<b>9 or more riders:</b>	4 motos Saturday, 2 motos Sunday then;
<b>9-16 riders:</b>	to deadman final
<b>17-32 riders:</b>	to deadman semis & deadman final
<b>33-64 riders:</b>	to quarters, semis & final (all deadman)
<b>65-80 riders:</b>	to eighths, quarters, semis & final (all deadman)

### MIGHTY 11 JUNIOR TEST TEAMS (New Zealand & Australia)

**NOTE:** All Mighty 11s riders are required to enter their Age Class or the Mighty 11 Class as applicable, in addition to the Test Team classes.

<b>Saturday:</b>	3 motos, beginning of rounds 2, 3, 4
<b>Sunday:</b>	2 motos, beginning of round 5 and end of round 6
<b>Points:</b>	10, 8, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1 (All points added. Team gate allocation)

### NORTH ISLAND CLASSIC UCI C1:

'Block' format racing. 3 mixed moto. Top 8 riders to 3 heat finals

**Saturday only:** UCI Annex 1 for all Seeding & transfer systems

### NI TITLES CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES:

'Block' format racing. 3 mixed moto. Top 8 riders to 3 heat finals

<b>Sunday only:</b>	5 - 8 riders - Points over 4 motos.
	9-16 riders - 3 motos, with riders to a 3 heat final.
	17+ riders - 3 motos, deadman semi, top 8 rider to 3 heat final.

### KIWI SPROCKETS:

Riders will ride in UCI age classes for this event. Standard racing formats apply.

### TIED POSITIONS:

All tied positions will be separated by Countback. No run-offs will be held.

### CONTINGENCY PLANS:

In case of disruption or weather, moto format may be changed, at the discretion of the Chief Commissaire. In cases of extreme delay or weather, Monday may be used as an alternate day for racing

### PRIZE GIVING:

This will be held trackside Sunday 22 October, approximately 30 minutes after the finish of racing.



### AWARDS & TROPHY ALLOCATION:

Determined from the time that entries close for Trophy purposes.  
For trophy placings, a count back method will be used to rank riders on equal points at the end of racing

#### Challenge & Championship Class

Classes with 8 riders or less: Trophies and Presentation Plates to 3<sup>rd</sup> place  
Classes with 9+ riders: Trophies to 3<sup>rd</sup> place and Presentation Plates to 8<sup>th</sup> place  
Personalised certificates will be sent to clubs as soon as available.

#### Mighty 11s Class

Trophies to 3<sup>rd</sup> place irrespective of gender,  
Presentation Plates to finalists in finishing order irrespective of gender

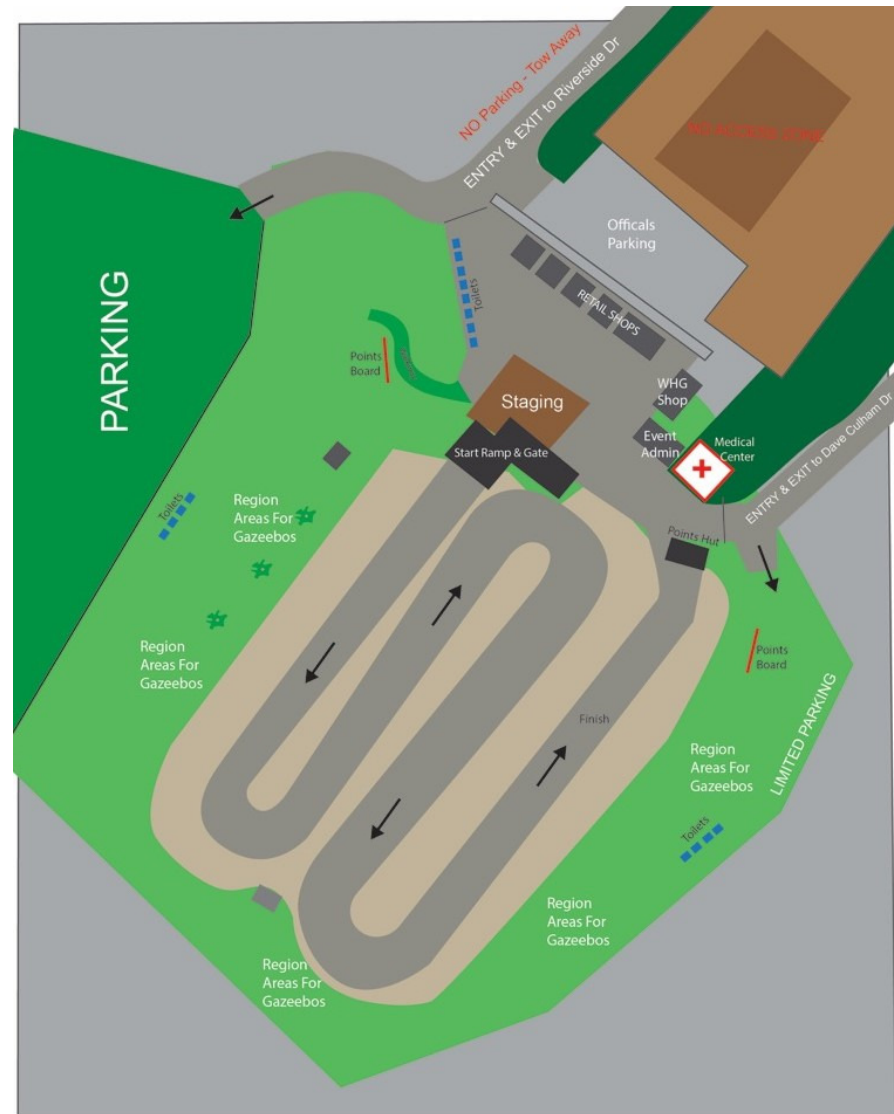

### BMXNZ EVENT HEALTH & SAFETY STATEMENT

In the event of injury to an event participant, a completed entry is consent to proper medical treatment being administered. Event entry also consents to submit to drug testing if required. All entrants agree to be bound by the regulations and general conditions for this event as published by BMXNZ in its latest rule book. Any reference to BMXNZ within this flyer or entry is referring to BMX New Zealand Inc.

Safety and safe practices at all BMXNZ calendared events are not negotiable and failure by anyone to comply by the code of conduct or rules of the sport will result in the removal of such person from the event facility.
