## SDP Development Squad Selection Guidelines

Whangarei Pre-Norths - Sunday 24 September 2017

Whangarei BMX Club and Facility

William Fraser Memorial Park, Pohe Island, Whangarei

**SDP Male – 4 riders**

**SDP Female – 4 riders**

This event will be to select a squad to develop & train in the SDP program & then travel to Australia in early 2017 to compete in the AUS series & UCI rounds.

The selection is open to riders who will be the set UCI age in 2017 below.

**Male - the top two 15yr & top two 14yr riders**

**Female - the top four 15yr & 14yr riders**

### RACE FORMAT - SDP Development Squad:

**Gender Split:** Separate Male & Female trial will be held

**Senior Male:** 8 or less riders - 6 motos, points over.

9+ riders - 4 motos, each rider's 3 best moto points will be added.

Top 4 scoring riders aged UCI 14 and UCI 15 will race a 3 heat final, with the top 2 of each age group being selected for the Squad.

**Senior Female:** 8 or less riders - 6 motos, points over.

9+ riders - 4 motos, each rider's 3 best moto points will be added.

Top 8 scoring riders aged UCI 15 and UCI 14 will race a 3 heat final, with the top 4 overall, being selected for the Squad.

BMX NZ moto mix for all qualifying motos. Points from the motos will not be carried over into the final heats. Lane selection for finals will utilise the BMX NZ Superclass Series lane rotation.

**ENTRY FEE:** \$35.00

**ENTRIES CLOSE:** Sunday 10 September 2017 - **NO LATE ENTRIES ACCEPTED**

**REGISTRATION:** Sunday 24 September 9.00 – 10.00 am.

### TERMS & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

1. All riders must compete at the 2017 BMX New Zealand North Island Titles meeting in classes as required by BMXNZ

2. Selected Riders and Guardians will be required to sign and comply with the BMX NZ Devo Squad Contract. Contracts are to be signed on the day of selection. Copies of the Devo Squad Contract are available upon request from the BMXNZ Administrator at admin@bmxnz.co.nz

3. Riders must be available to attend all Squad training sessions as arranged by BMXNZ Devo Squad Management.

4. It is not mandatory for riders entering the trials to also enter their age class in 20" or Cruiser classes at the Pre-North's Meeting.

5. Information contained within this flyer supersedes all other information or flyers previously provided

6. All riders must abide by the rules and regulations as set by BMX NZ and the 2017 Devo Squad management

7. Any rider wanting to be eligible for selection for a BMX New Zealand Team must be permanently resident, in New Zealand for the all of the relevant BMX New Zealand racing season (as published in the annual racing calendar) and up to the date or dates of the events for which the rider wishes to be considered for selection . "Permanently Resident" means actually living in New Zealand, and intending to live here indefinitely.

### SELECTED SDP DEVO SQUAD RIDERS:

All selected riders must provide a copy of a current passport and entry visa to Australia (if required) to the Devo Squad Manager by 30 November 2017.

Riders must be available in January 2018 to travel to Australia. It will be the rider's responsibility to get to and from Auckland Airport. All Devo Squad members will fly on the same flight to and from Australia from Auckland Airport.

Riders must provide a copy of their travel insurance to the Devo Squad Manager prior to 30 November 2017, covering the rider for accidents involving BMX racing.

Riders selected for the Devo Squad will be required to pay to BMX NZ \$500.00 to assist with covering costs of the Australian part of the program.

### BMXNZ EVENT HEALTH & SAFETY STATEMENT

All entrants agree to be bound by the regulations and general conditions for this event as published by BMXNZ in its latest rule book.
