WHAT ARE WCJEQ & YOG EVENTS

After the change in the HP program, BMXNZ have been more involved in delivering a selection model to be more realistic for Championship Jnr riders in New Zealand. These events will target Championship Jnr riders for 2018, so the first event in 2017 will accept UCI 16yr riders (or UCI 17yr riders looking to race next season at 2nd year Jnr) to race up with the first year Jnrs. At Norths you will just race your AGE groups as per normal. After January the 1st, the WCJEQ events are just the Championship Jnr classes at the event noted below.

Results & performances will be recorded & used for selection purposes under the CNZ BMX Selection Regulations 2018. The events riders will be selected for are the UCI 2018 World Championships & the 2018 Youth Olympic Games

EVENT WEIGHTING

The WCJEQ / YOG events will be the main focus with selectors for the purpose of seeing how NZ riders achieve against each other. But as per the CNZ selection regulations there are weighting processes, so that results outside of the basic event list can sway selection decisions. Following are the events, their priority & weighting as per the CNZ Selection Regulations.

Event Priority Men's Juniors and Women's Juniors;

UCI C1 and CC event results and performances.

UCI CN event (BMXNZ Championship Nationals) results and performances;

BMXNZ WCJEQ/YOG Event results and performances;

Weighting Note1: Results used for selection purposes will focus on Quarter finals or above. Any lesser finals may be noted, moto results will not be considered.

Weighting Note2: BMXNZ WCJEQ events are weighted in the following order

- AUS Series Round 17/18 Feb 2017
- NZ Rounds 1/3/4/5
- North Island Titles Round 2

Weighting Note3: Supercross event results for Jnrs will be considered as part of the selection criteria if the results meet the levels as specified in Weighting Note1

WCJEQ EVENT DATES

EVENT 1 SUNSET COAST BMX (8m) - 15th October 2017 - special class & races

EVENT 2 WHANGAREI NORTHS EVENT - 22nd October 2017 - race in age classes

EVENT 3 CHRISTCHURCH SOUTHS EVENT - 13th January 2018 - race in Champ Jnr class

EVENT 4 BMXA Series R1 NSW - 17/18th February 2018 - race in Champ Jnr class

EVENT 5 SUNSET COAST BMX (8m)- 25th February 2018 - race in Champ Jnr class

EVENT 6 NEW PLYMOUTH BMX NATs - 31st March 2018 - race in Champ Jnr class

- Note - Event 1 & 5 will be 8m ramp with amateur straights.
- New Zealand WCJEQ events have no entry cost. At Events 1 & 5 entry to other event is needed (age group or MICO series)
- BMXNZ is waiting on UCI confirmation on the Championship Nationals event date, which will define event location.

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WCJEQ / YOG RACE FORMAT

Event 1 will be 3 motos & deadman finals as required. Entry is for all first year Champ Jnrs & UCI 16/17yr riders. Format to replicate a standard UCI C1 type event.

Event 2 will be run as NORTHS age format, riders will be in UCI16 & or Champ Jnrs.

Event 3, 5 & 6 will be run to the standard BMXNZ Championship Jnr class format for all these events

Event 4 will be run to BMXA class formats

SELECTION PROCESS

The selection criteria is detailed in the CNZ selection documents. All riders & parents must read & understand these documents.

Final 2018 CNZ Selection Regulation documents have yet to be supplied by CNZ, however BMXNZ has been advised the WCJEQ/YOG events form part of these regulations.

AUS EVENT TRAVEL

BMXNZ is open to planning a travelling group with a BMXNZ selector and/or manager. This is to assist sending riders to the AUS event without parents or family to assist in the cost of travelling to the event. Similar to other BMXNZ team offers, a travel plan will be produced & a cost advised per person. BMXNZ will look to offer transport, management of the group & basic race support. This will be a user pay option. Details to be confirmed.

FURTHER DETAILS

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BMXNZ EVENT HEALTH & SAFETY STATEMENT FOR NZ EVENTS.

BMXNZ, The Regions & BMX Clubs involved will comply with the requirements of the Health and Safety in Employment Act 2015 by committing to providing and maintaining a safe and healthy environment for all riders, families and visitors to the BMX Event facility. It is the sports policy to "make every practical and reasonable effort to protect all visitors, to prevent accidents or serious harm injuries and promote safety and welfare of all persons while on the event facility".

BMXNZ, The Regions & BMX Clubs involved will take all possible steps to list and evaluate hazards and to determine solutions to eliminate or minimise those hazards as part of the Risk Management Plan (RMP), to meet the sports policy noted above.

BMX Racing is an action sport & inherently has risks that are accepted as part of sport. All known risks are noted in the BMXNZ Meeting RMP & this is available onsite during any event. Parties wanting to assess the RMP prior to entry must contact the club for detail. Entry to this event confirms an understanding of the risks of the sport as noted in the RMP. In the event of injury to an event participant, a completed entry is consent to proper medical treatment being administered. Event entry also consents to submit to drug testing if required. All entrants agree to be bound by the regulations and general conditions for this event as published by BMXNZ in its latest rule book. Any reference to BMXNZ within this flyer or entry is referring to BMX New Zealand Inc.

Safety and safe practices at all BMXNZ calendared events are not negotiable and failure by anyone to comply by the code of conduct or rules of the sport will result in the removal of such person from the event facility.
